LUKOIL MAKES ADVANCE PAYMENT OF USD 500 MILLION FOR A USD 1.2
BILLION LOAN

Today OAO LUKOIL has made partial advance payment for a loan of USD 1.2 billion attracted in August 2009, with the maturity of 3 years.

Advance payment of USD 500 million was made on account of the Company's internal funds generated during the first half of 2010, which proves a strong financial position and sufficient liquidity level of the LUKOIL Group.

As reported earlier, the loan was secured by proceeds from oil export contracts.
