LUKOIL AND SIBUR ENTER IN AN AMICABLE AGREEMENT ON
LOKOSOVSKY GAS-PROCESSING PLANT

AO LUKOIL, OOO LUKOIL-Western Siberia, AO AK Sibur, AO Sibur-Tyumen and AO Lokosovsky GPK have signed an amicable agreement.

According to this Agreement, AO AK Sibur and AO Sibur-Tyumen recognize the legality and legitimacy of establishing AO Lokosovsky GPK and the sale-purchase of 100% of its shares in favor of OOO LUKOIL-Western Siberia and AO LUKOIL in December 2001.

In its turn, OOO LUKOIL-Western Siberia will make an additional payment worth \$20 million for the earlier purchased shares of AO Lokosovsky GPK.

The project capacity of Lokosovsky gas-processing complex is 1.07 billion cubic meters annually. The Complex includes a gas-processing plant, a booster pump station and a pipeline network exceeding 100 kilometers in length. The plant was put into operation in the early 80-s. It currently employs 700 people. OOO LUKOIL-Western Siberia plans to upgrade the complex and increase its associated gas processing capacity up to 1.5 billion cubic meters.
