LUKOIL IMPROVES MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR EASTERN EUROPEAN  
SEGMENT OF PETROLEUM PRODUCT SUPPLIES

The OAO LUKOIL Press Service announces that as a result of a restructuring of the management system for LUKOIL Group's foreign entities supplying petroleum products, the headquarters of the Eastern European Interregional Association (IRA) has moved from Minsk to Kyiv.
